1 Name, Scope and Level of the Course

The course is provided by the University of Skövde and is named English: Preparatory Course G1N. It comprises 7.5 credits and is on Basic level, the level of progression of the course is G1N.

2 Objectives

After completed course the student should be able to:

- utilise basic vocabulary
- identify and utilise basic grammatical and phonetic concepts
- apply basic phonetic and grammatical rules in their oral proficiency
- apply basic grammatical rules in their written proficiency

3 Course Content

The course comprises studies of basic patterns of grammar and pronunciation, reading and comprehension of texts and oral and written practice.

4 Forms of Teaching

The teaching comprises lectures, seminars/group discussions and exercises.

The teaching is conducted in English.

5 Examination

The course is graded Excellent (A), Very Good (B), Good (C), Satisfactory (D), Sufficient (E), Fail (F).

To achieve a final grade in this course the following must be met:

For a final grade of A, 4.5 hp must reach grade A and 3 hp of at least grade B.

Grade B, at least 7.5 hp of at least grade B.

Grade C, at least 4.5 hp of at least grade C and 3 hp of at least grade D.

Grade D, at least 4.5 hp of at least grade D and 3 hp of at least grade E.

Grade E requires 7.5 hp of at least grade E.

The final grade is issued when both course units reach at least grade E.

6 Admission Requirements

Basic eligibility for university studies and a completed placement test.

7 Subject, Main Field of Study and Disciplinary Domain

The course forms a part of the academic subject area of English. The course is not a part of any main field of study at the University of Skövde. The disciplinary domain of the course is The Humanities.

Every course at the University of Skövde belongs to a *subject*. The division of subjects is used for follow-up and quality assurance. A *main field of study* is an area in which a degree can be awarded. *Disciplinary domain* is a division which is used by the government for the allocation of resources for studies at undergraduate level and advanced level.

8 Decision on the Course and Ratification of the Course syllabus

This course was approved by the Curriculum Committee for Health Dec 19, 2017. This course syllabus was ratified by the Curriculum Committee for Health Dec 19, 2017. It is valid from Jul 1, 2018.

9 Restrictions

This course cannot be accredited within a degree.
