Listening

I can understand extended speech and lectures in English and follow even complex lines of argument provided that the topic is reasonably familiar. I can understand most TV news and current affairs programmes. I can understand the majority of films in standard English.

Reading

I can read articles and reports concerned with contemporary problems in which the writers adopt particular attitudes or viewpoints. I can understand contemporary literary prose.

Spoken interaction

I can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers of English possible. I can take an active part in discussions in familiar contexts, accounting for and sustaining my views.

Spoken production

I can present clear, detailed descriptions on a wide range of subjects related to my field of interest. I can explain a viewpoint on a topical issue, giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

Writing

I can write clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects related to my interests. I can write an essay or report, passing on information or giving reasons in support of or against a particular point of view. I can write letters highlighting the personal significance of events and experiences.
